In this issue we put for your consideration, a guide Allergy to Breaths, prepared by the Subject Committee, of the Argentine Association of Allergy and Clinical Immunology. Another aspect presented here is drug reactions in patients suffering from HIV. Finally, we present a work and model of various effects of the Methylentetrahydrofolate reductase (MTHFR) gene presented at the invitation of Professor DR Sadi Cossy Isasi. He analyzes the effects of the gene in various pathologies, different from those of Thrombophilia, its first aspect and is currently connected with Asthma, Allergy, IL 17, metabolic aspects of folic acid and vitamin B12 its impact on immune response, as well as the use of flavonoids and their implication in inflammation, oxidation and anti-cancer. Its application is broad
